## Types of narrative essays

- **Autobiographical narrative essay**

You can also define it as a **personal narrative essay**. When you choose a topic on such an essay, try to pick a subject that interests you. Some of the **narrative essay topics** that come within this category are:

- Speak about your feeling about receiving a graduation degree
- A recent travel experience.

## How to write a Narrative Essay: a step by step guide



It is always preferable for a student to write a narrative essay in Chronological order. Following are the steps which you can consider for flawless narrative essay writing.

### **Choose a Topic**

### **Format and structure**

It will start with an introduction paragraph back with three body paragraphs and then a conclusion. In the first paragraph, mention the rising action. The second main body paragraph must have the climax, and the last body paragraph must have the falling action. Also, maintain a specific style of writing, don't change it frequently.

### **Outline**

### **Introduction**

### **Thesis Statement**

### **Body p**

In the main body, you can write the story and state-related facts and details. Here, it would help if you guided the readers through your affirmative thoughts. Try to keep at least three paragraphs in the body of the essays. Try to keep the word count within the limit stated by your college/ professor.

## Tips on writing a narrative essay

- **Draft the elements**

- **Give supporting facts**

We can easily place a statement or our opinion. But, whether the facts are correct or not needs some supporting elements. You must provide valid proof, examples, or case studies with the idea you have stated while writing a narrative essay. It may involve some arguments also.

- **Avoid unnecessary facts**

Some students tend to exaggerate the facts. You must avoid it while writing a narrative essay. Also, don't give any information that is irrelevant to the topic. It will make your narrative article too wordy. As a result, the readers will become confused.

- **Clarity in writing**

Try to keep the text simple and easy to read. Don't make it too complicated that makes the reader hard to understand. Also, if you write an easily understandable essay, you will get good feedback from the readers.

- **Maintain chronological order**

Keep a standard order in your essay headings. It is better to maintain a chronological order so that you can avoid any types of confusion. Every individual has a specific writing style; it's time

to keep the same in the entire article. You may also create a theme and follow the same in your narrative essay.

- **Site some examples**

- Don't write too many details such that it becomes too wordy
- Try not to state a story, instead visualize the same
